- Respect other Active Life Centre users
- Allow others to speak

ZERO TOLERANCE:

- No fighting or hitting other people
- Pick up litter and put in waste bin
- If you see someone being bullied, let staff know
- No shouting or screaming
- No calling of names or being rude to people
- Do not run in the corridors
- No swearing
- No riding or using own equipment within the centre (Scooters, Bikes, etc)

PARTICIPATION:

- Make new members welcome
- Be a good role model to other young people
- Positively participate in all Youth Club activities
- If you're not happy with anything that is happening, talk to staff – unless staff know, they can't help!

CONSEQUENCES:

If you don't keep to the ground rules, there are consequences!

These are:

- If you break a ground rule, you will usually get a warning, but if your behaviour is very bad, you could be sent home immediately, and your parents will be contacted to come and collect you.
- You only get two warnings per evening, then you'll be sent home and your parents will be told.
- If you are sent home, you will be banned from the youth club for a week.
